**Bluenose-East Management Proposal**

The Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Department of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) and Tłıchǵ Government have jointly submitted a management proposal for the Bluenose-East barren-ground caribou herd to the Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB).

The GNWT is pleased to share the management proposal for you to review and to provide input if you anticipate any adverse impacts to your asserted or established Aboriginal or treaty rights as a result of the management proposal. Should you identify any possible adverse impacts, ENR requests that you share with us the specific details in writing by April 1, 2022.

This joint GNWT/Tłıchǵ Government management proposal was formally submitted to the WRRB on January 28, 2022. The management proposal provides background information on herd status and outlines proposed management actions that are intended to promote continued stabilization and recovery of the Bluenose-East herd.
