Amendment to Wildlife Research Permit – WL501155

The above noted Wildlife Research Permit, entitled: **Monitoring of the Bathurst, Bluenose-East, and Beverly caribou herds** has been issued and expires April 30, 2024.

We are contacting you to consider an amendment to this permit to allow the temporary addition of audiloggers to 20 collars going out on Bathurst and Bluenose-East caribou in the spring of 2024. These audiloggers weigh less than 150 g and would be attached to the exterior of the collar from March to September (7 months) 2024, when they are programmed to drop off. Additional details can be found in the attached research proposal.
