Wildlife Research Permit Application for Moose Research and Monitoring

Please find attached a Wildlife Research Permit application for Allicia Kelly, ENR, GNWT to conduct the project titled “**Moose ecology and monitoring in the Mackenzie and Tłı̨chų Highway study areas**”.

As part of this project, up to 20 adult female moose will be collared and monitored to learn more about moose movements, habitat use, and how moose are affected by other herbivores such as bison and boreal caribou. The study area includes the Mackenzie and Tłı̨chų Highway areas between Fort Providence, Whatı̨, and Behchokų. Field work is planned for March 2023.

The research permit application form requires brief summaries, so I have included a document with additional details. An information fact sheet on the interrelated Sentinel North-funded project to study food-web dynamics is also attached (“Understanding Food Security in the Northern Boreal Forest”).
