## **NOTICE OF REVISED BATHURST CARIBOU JOINT PROPOSAL**

The Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) wishes to advise you that the Government of the Northwest Territories and the Tłıchǫ Government have submitted a *Revised Joint Proposal on Caribou Management Actions in Wek'èezhì* to the Board on May 31, 2010. The Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board met last week to review the revised proposal and on Monday to review responses from all Parties about the continuation of the Bathurst Caribou proceeding.

The Board notes that several of the Parties expressed continuing concerns about information or reports which have not been disclosed and which may be relevant to the proceeding. While the Board recognizes that caribou management is critically important in Wek'èezhì, the Board must ensure that its process is fair.

Consequently, the Parties to the proceeding have been asked to identify any information or reports which are relevant and material to the cases being brought before the Board by June 18, 2010. The Board will review these requests and identify information which it agrees will be relevant and helpful. Once the Board has the information requests from the proponents, it will set out a timeline for the completion of the proceeding.
