Key points:

- would prefer 0 quota as it is easier to enforce and fairer to all in that the herd is at risk and **no one** should harvest until there are signs of recovery;
- if 300 is acceptable to the Board then we would recommend the animals be taken in a controlled community hunt similar to those organized by ENR this past winter. The allocation of any number harvested should be delegated at a per capita ratio between the Tlicho and the Yellowknives Dene and the distribution of the harvested animals should be left to their discretion.
- the harvest should include maximum scientific sampling, etc.
- the rest of our comments made at the previous hearing stand. No evidence to date that the ENR numbers are far off the mark or that the herd is recovering
