Please find an application for a Wildlife Research Permit to continue with the ***NWT Small Mammal and Hare Survey*** at various locations in the Northwest Territories. Please also find a copy of our report on activities performed from 2015 to 2019. A small version of the 2019 update poster is also attached. If you would like a full colour version of this poster, please let us know and it will be our pleasure to send you a copy.

Although it is possible to apply for a multi-year permit for wildlife research, this application is for one year only (2020). The survey is in transition and investigating changing methods from snap traps to live traps at some sites, especially if a site does not require specimens for disease testing near our southern border. After this year, the survey may apply for a new multi-year permit when methods have been settled in the longer term. The survey will also apply for an Northwest Territories Wildlife Care Committee handling permit.
