



NOTICE OF PROCEEDING AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD – BATHURST CARIBOU HERD

On January 22, 2019, the Tłı̄chǝ Government (TG) and Department of Environment & Natural Resources (ENR), Government of Northwest Territories submitted the “*Joint Proposal on Management Actions for the Bathurst ʔekwǝ (Barren-ground caribou) Herd 2019-2021*” to the Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) outlining proposed management actions for the Bathurst caribou herd in Wek'èezhì.

Following an initial assessment of the Bathurst management proposal, the Board has determined that a Level 2 review is appropriate, as per its Rule for Management Proposals. Therefore, the Board has established a proceeding and an online public registry.

Anyone interested in providing comment on the Bathurst caribou management proposal may do so in writing through email or fax by March 15, 2019. This proposal can be viewed on the Public Registry at www.wrrb.ca.

Following the public comment period, the WRRB will review the management proposal during its next board meeting, tentatively scheduled for March 2019, and make recommendations on the proposed management actions.
