



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – BATHURST CARIBOU HERD

On December 15, 2015, the Tłıchq Government (TG) and Department of Environment & Natural Resources (ENR), Government of Northwest Territories submitted the *“Joint Proposal on Caribou Management Actions for the Bathurst Herd: 2016-2019”* to the Wek'èezhìi Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) outlining proposed management actions for the Bathurst Caribou Herd in Wek'èezhìi.

The WRRB wishes to advise that its Public Hearing related to the 2016 Bathurst Caribou Herd Joint Management Proposal is scheduled for **February 23-24, 2016** in **Yellowknife, NT** at the **Northern United Place Auditorium** (5403 - 50 Avenue). The Hearing will focus on management actions identified in the proposal, including the closure of all harvesting of the Bathurst caribou herd and the development of mobile wolf-hunter camps.

The Hearing will begin daily at 9:00 a.m. and go to 4:00 p.m. Daily opportunities for the general public to make statements will be provided. A complete draft agenda can be found on the WRRB's Public Registry: www.wrrb.ca.

Following the Public Hearing, the WRRB will review all information received during its Proceeding and submit its determinations and/or recommendations to TG and ENR related to the entire Joint Management Proposal, by no later than May 13, 2016.
