Mr. Andre:

During our 29 June 2010 meeting, the Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) reviewed your 25 June 2010 request to post a document, entitled "*Tuktu and Nogak Project, A Caribou Chronicle, Final Report, March 31, 2001*", to the Board's public registry. After careful consideration, the Board's decision is not to post the requested document to the public registry as the document is not relevant for the Board's analysis of the revised proposal (Motion #179-06-29-2010).

Further, the Board will not add the document requested 1 July 2010, entitled "*Climate, snow, ice, crashes, and declines in populations of reindeer and caribou (Rangifer tarandus L.)*", to the public registry. These decisions do not prevent you from using the information contained within these documents during your final arguments at the WRRB's public hearing.
