on Proposed Emergency Interim Measures for the Bathurst Caribou Herd**

In our meeting of November 10, 2009, you mentioned your interest in presenting to the Wek'èezhìi Renewable Resources Board (WRRB or "the Board") your department's rationale and reasons for pursuing Emergency Measures with respect to protecting the Bathurst caribou herd.

The Board will be holding its next meeting on December 10-11, 2009 in Yellowknife and are pleased to invite you to speak to its members during this meeting. We have tentatively scheduled your presentation for 1:15 pm on December 10, 2009, at the Denedeh Manor Boardroom at 4504 49th Avenue. As a consideration to our members, we would be interested in receiving a summary of the proposed Interim Measures with the proposed implementation timeline. These can be provided in digital format via email, no later than December 8, 2009.

As part of your presentation and consistent with s.12.5.14 of the Tåîchô Agreement, the Board requests the following:

- 1) The reasons for concluding there is an emergency;
- 2) What has occurred since the proposal was submitted that created an emergency situation;
