Wildlife Research Permit Application – Tłıchq All-Season Road (TASR) Wildlife Studies (Camera Program)

As per section 12.5.1 of the Tłıchq Agreement, the Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) considers the above-mentioned Wildlife Research Permit application as a management proposal. The Board understands that the objective of the camera trapping program to document boreal caribou and their predators along the proposed TASR.

The proposed research, scheduled for January 1 to December 31, 2021, along the TASR between Whatì and the junction with Highway 3, involves the following:

- Check and download data from 10 previously installed remote wildlife cameras; and,
- Access by truck, snowmobile, ATV or Argo.

The WRRB has no concerns with the project as presented in your application. We encourage community members with local Tłıchq knowledge to participate in the monitoring program. The WRRB requests that results be provided to the Board upon completion of work.
