**Re: Harvest information on Bathurst herd**

Dear Sirs:

As indicated in our letter of November 13, 2009, a proceeding has been initiated by the Wek'èezhii Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) for the consideration of the joint proposal for management of caribou in Wek'èezhii, submitted by Tłı̄chǫ Government and Government of the Northwest Territories. The proposal includes measures for restricting harvest of the Bathurst herd as a means of aiding recovery.

The WRRB has authority under the Tłı̄chǫ Agreement to make decisions on the Total Allowable Harvest of wildlife in Wek'èezhii and the allocation of such harvest. In the event that the Board will make a decision of this nature, the Board will benefit from as much information on harvest of the Bathurst herd as is available.

We, therefore, respectfully request any information your organization may have on the harvest of Bathurst caribou in Nunavut. If you could respond to this request by March 12, 2010 it would be greatly appreciated.
